Greetings from the country of Panamá!

In our last letter we asked you to pray for an upcoming building project. We are excited to update you that the actual construction of the two classrooms, a storage room, and a bathroom are completed. Next phase is for the ceiling, lighting, flooring, doors and window. We have already started using the classrooms for Sunday school. Please continue to pray for the funds to finish the project.

We also are gearing up for our next construction project: a covered carport for our church vehicles. This area will also be used for classrooms/activities.

This year we have a goal of helping couples get married. We have many couples living together. Here, to get legally married, each person must have certain medical exams, etc. We offered to help with the expenses. We also are offering to have their church ceremony, helping with the expenses. So far this year we have had ten couples get legally married. We are excited to see what God is doing in our couples. Please pray for the families in our church.

We were contacted by someone who used to attend our church. He was able to get us Bibles to be gifted out. We were able to get 3,500 Bibles which we handed out to the local pastors and ministries. We are praying for this door to remain open for us to be able to receive more Bibles to give out. We were able to give out 600 Bibles last year at a conference we preached off the coast of Veraguas, Panamá.

When it rains it pours, so they say. This week the transmission on our big old yellow church bus went out and the radiator broke on our church van. We are grateful that neither broke down while transporting people. The radiator we got repaired. We are looking into the logistics of the transmission for the bus. Please pray for God to show us what is best. It might be time to start praying for another coaster bus.

We continue to teach at local seminaries and support local pastors/missionaries with different activities. Our prayer is Panama for Jesus.
